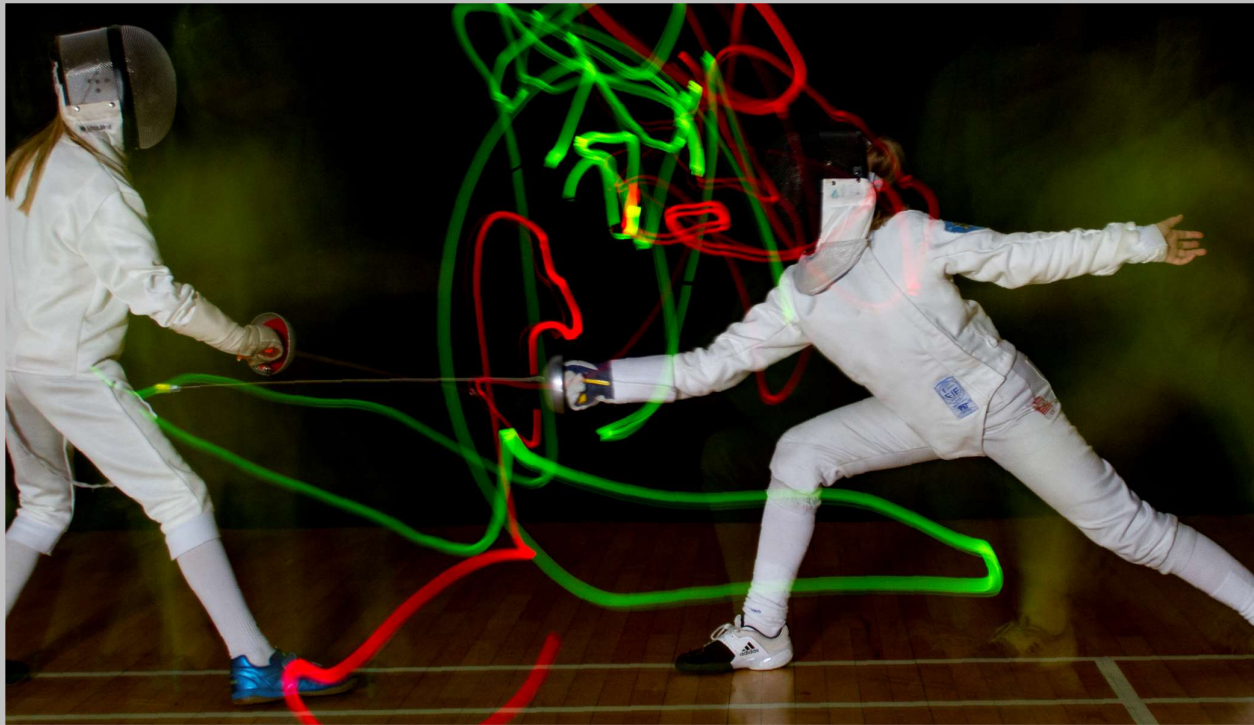


EARN YOUR DEGREE, A SALARY AND COACHING EXPERIENCE ALL IN ONE
