# Nordic Challenge 2023:

Oslo Cup Senior Tournament is part of Nordic Challenge 2023 Included tournaments:

- 16-17 September: Challenge Bernadotte, Stockholm SWE
- 23-24 September: Kupittaa Tournament, Turku/Åbo FIN
- 7 October: Nordic Championships, Kääriku, EST
- 28-29 October: Oslo Cup, Oslo NOR

The total prize pool for the Nordic Challenge is 2000 EUR each for men and women. No extra registration is needed. The competitions included requires (only) national fencing license. Winner is the fencer with best total result in the four competitions. (Lowest total sum of placement.) A "no start" is counted as a result equal to the number of participants +1. If results are tied, the highest number of first place, most second, etc. is the tiebreaker. If an exact tie, the Oslo competition is the tiebreaker.

Prizes:

1. prize in Nordic Challenge 1000 EUR 2. prize in Nordic Challenge 700 EUR 3. prize in Nordic Challenge 300 EUR Prize money are paid out by the Norwegian federation against receipts for fencing related costs (equipment, travel, etc.)

Senior tournaments: y.o.b. 2010 and older

U23 tournaments: y.o.b. 2001-2010

#### **Entry fee**

Senior: EUR 40 / NOK 500. U23: EUR 30 / NOK 350. Senior and U23: EUR 60 / NOK 700.

Paid in cash EUR or NOK or by card at registration/payment. VIPPS payment system is accepted. The entry fee can also be paid for by each club delegation by bank transfer to: Bygdø Fekteklubb (Bygdø Fencing Club), IBAN: NO09 7001 0519 185, at no later date than <u>October 22nd, 2023.</u>

#### **Referee Obligation**

#### The number with at least national grade referees that must accompany club teams is:

1–4 starts **totally** from one club (men and women): No obligation to provide a referee

5–9 starts: One referee two days

10 or more fencers: Two referees two days

The name(s) of the referee(s) are entered must be notified together with entries of the fencers.

Should a club not provide the required number of referees, a fine EUR 150 / NOK 1800 for one missing referee per day will be inflicted.

# Formula

The Oslo Cup Senior competitions shall use the F.I.E. formula for junior competitions (cf. 0.35-0.41) except that all 100% are promoted to DE.

The Oslo Cup U23 competitions shall consist of one round of pools, all 100% promoted to DE with repêchage.

# Awards

- Four best fencers in senior men's competitions
- Four best fencers in senior women's competitions
- Four best fencers in U23 men's competitions
- Four best fencers in U23 women's competitions
- The best veteran fencers (open class 40+) in both senior competitions
